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Information about enrolment and invoicing

In the event that your teacher is unable to make one of your lessons (due to sickness or unforeseen circumstances), parents/ care givers will be notified as soon as practical. An alternative lesson date and time will be provided by the teacher to make up for the class.

The Music With AIM program is sequential, and as such, your child will receive the maximum benefits by being involved throughout the year and across the developmental stages (Baby- Toddler-Preschool). Although it is not ideal, should you choose to discontinue music classes at the end of a term, please ensure you notify Music With AIM at least 2 weeks prior to the commencement of the subsequent term to avoid being invoiced.

The Music With AIM fee structure is consistent with sporting clubs, music conservatoriums, dance schools and the like. Please note that invoicing is per term. In order to support the continuation of this unique program for your child/children, discounts for missed lessons are not available.
